In this hands-on session, you'll gain an understanding of the terminology, types, and structures of rubrics in Brightspace, gain hands-on practice in constructing a rubric, and discover how and where students see rubrics, both before and after their work is graded.

Brightspace Special Topics: Introduction to Intelligent Agents

Brightspace's Intelligent Agents tool allows instructors to craft automated notifications to be sent to students when specified course performance criteria are met. These agents can help faculty manage communications in courses with large enrollments, as well as create and schedule messages to be sent to students who are not routinely logging in or who have missed work. In this workshop, participants will learn how and why to use intelligent agents, how to create them, how to schedule them, and more.

Brightspace Special Topics: Virtual Reality & 3D Interactive Content

This session introduces you to tools and resources for VR/3D models, demonstrates how to embed these interactive models into Brightspace course content, then demonstrates how learners can interact with the models.
